Treasurer's Report

Alumni Brothers,

Annual Dues Renewal — If you have paid your Alumni Chapter dues in the past through our online payment portal, you probably received "an invoice" by email on June 1 seeking dues renewal. Our chapter operates on a July 1 fiscal year, so the online system we contract with sends out the invoice automatically on June 1. We are told that the system will send out a reminder again on July 1 whether you have paid or not. Sorry about that, but that's how the system is programmed. Let me clarify the Alumni Chapter's policy on dues. Dues are voluntary. We think we do good things with the \$50 dues we collect, but we do not want dues to be an impediment to anyone participating. All brothers are "always welcome here" whether or not you pay the dues.

Secondly, we do not expect brothers to pay dues more than once a year. If you last paid dues on February 1, for instance, you might wish to wait until next February. You can, of course, wait to pay on your own schedule. If you do not recall when you last paid, send me an email and I will gladly look it up.

The Dues & Donations Chart that gets included in the monthly newsletter will be adjusted to show the names of brothers who have paid "within the previous 12 months."

By the way, you can also pay dues by mailing a check to the Alumni Chapter P.O. Box. (See below for the form that you can send with your check.) If you pay that way, you probably did not get the emailed "invoice." If you pay by check, it takes me longer to add your name to the Dues & Donations Chart. I apologize for that. It is simple logistics. We have to pick up the mail, deposit it, report it to me, and update the chart. But you are welcome to pay either by check or online. Or come to an Alumni meeting and drop it off! Every brother is always welcome.

I want to thank those of you who wrote me messages of condolence when it was announced last August that I was appointed the new Alumni Chapter Treasurer. I want to dispel the rumor that I was tagged with this job because I missed an Alumni Chapter meeting -although I suppose that is good incentive not to miss meetings! Like all of us, I appreciate so much the years of service from Brothers Fischer, Flores, Patton, Ballinger, Robinson and others before them. Not to mention the generosity of others toward the Foundation and House Corp. People volunteer when they see value in the enterprise. Our collective brotherhood obviously creates value judging by how many of us choose to participate. That's why our Fresno Alumni Chapter ranks consistently among the best in the nation. And our support of the Active Chapter helps them to always be the best Fraternity choice on campus. That's a fact!

To be candid, this Treasurer job I volunteered for is not very complicated. My primary job is to keep track of dues receipts and to manage the checking account. The Housing Corp and the Foundation have their own Treasurers. When you designate donations to those entities, I simply send those funds to Brother Ballinger (for the Housing Corp) or to the Fresno State Alumni Association (which manages our Foundation funds).

The Alumni Chapter maintains two bank accounts a checking account and a money market account, both no-fee accounts at Premier Valley Bank. As of May 31, our checking account balance is \$2,740.36. These are basically funds from dues. Our expenditures consist of such minor items as: cost of alumni meeting dinners for speakers and up to 5 active chapters brothers, quarterly payments for a small Derrel's Mini-Storage space for chapter memorabilia, monthly fees for our online payment portal, graduation "stoles" for graduating Actives, Derby Day ad and other Active chapter support, newsletter production fees, etc. We pay a \$250 annual fee to the national fraternity and a fee to the State of California to maintain the foundation nonprofit status. (Brother Brad does all that work.)

The Money Market account has a balance of \$10,472.51. This is a modest Reserve/Rainy Day Fund for the Alumni Chapter. For instance, we are holding a \$2,500 reserve to pay for a Brother Phillip Sanchez Highway 41 Memorial sign, when that is implemented.

As you know, our members have been extremely generous in donations to the Foundation, from which the scholarships to Active brothers are drawn. I do not handle those funds except occasionally on a pass-thru basis. Likewise, the money spent on Memorial Bricks is deposited in the Foundation accounts. I do not handle Bricks, although that term was occasionally used in reference to my free throws back in my Sigma Chi intramural basketball days....

In other words, the Alumni Chapter runs on your dues payments and it is not a huge fund. As I said above, the \$50 annual dues payments are voluntary, but it does allow a lot of good brotherhood to happen!


