FRESNO SIGMA CHI ENDOWMENT AWARDS \$44,000

Active Chapter Scholarship Chairman, Erik Barrera (21-F), helped coordinate the banquet which was held at The Old Spaghetti Factory on September 18, 2023. There were 29 undergraduate brothers, 16 future pledges and 8 alumni who attended. During the presentation, 12 Active Chapter brothers were given Certificates of Academic Excellence, and each will receive \$3,666 for the 2023.2024 school year for a total of \$44,000. The average CGPA for the 12 recipients is 3.43.

Approved Tuition Hike Totals \$2,000 Over Five Years at Fresno State, Other CSU Campuses

Beginning in 2025, the amount and number of scholarships will gain in importance to our undergraduate brothers beginning in 2025. The California State University Board of Directors approved raising tuition 6% per year for 5 years.

Today the sticker price for a full-time student is \$6,974 for 2 semesters. Sticker price includes tuition plus additional mandatory fees.

Fees differ by institution and may fund library services, student gym facilities, student centers, technology resources and campus health centers

Under the schedule, the annual undergraduate tuition less mandatory fees for CSU will increase from the current \$5,742 to \$6,084 in the 2024-25 school year. The total would jump to \$6,450 the

following year, then to \$6,840 in 2026-27, then to \$7,248 and ultimately to \$7,682 in 2028-29. This compounded is a 33.7% increase.

The total cost is the sticker price, plus the cost of room and board, books and supplies, and transportation and personal expenses. At California State University, Fresno, the estimated total cost is \$22,891 for in-state students.




