President's Message





On October 5, 2024, the Ambassador Phillip V. Sanchez California State Highway 41 Memorial Bridge was dedicated with the unveiling of a commemorative sign to be placed at the bridge location. This public unveiling was held at Pinedale Elementary in the Phillip V. Sanchez Hall.

Phillip V. Sanchez (52-T), a recipient of the Order of Constantine and Significant Sig honors, was the first Consul of the Epsilon Eta Chapter at California State University, Fresno (formerly Fresno State College) in 1952. Brother Sanchez served in the Nixon, Ford, and Reagan administrations, rising to become one of the highest-ranking Hispanic appointees in U.S. history and the first Spanish-

speaking U.S. Ambassador to Latin America.

Entering the Chapter Eternal in 2017, Ambassador Sanchez was a distinguished diplomat, dedicated public servant, journalist, and humanitarian.

COLLECTION AT FRESNO STATE

LEO WILSON (55-F): A NEW BEAT ON LIFE

Twelve years ago, Leo Wilson, a Central Valley native and well-known home builder and developer, started experiencing fatigue and would wake up gasping for air at night. Over the years, it got to the point where he could hardly move.

In 2023, Leo's wife felt something was wrong and called for an ambulance. He was taken to Saint Agnes Medical Center's Emergency Department where doctors discovered he was suffering from heart failure and needed emergency surgery.

"I came in and went straight up to the floor and then they started putting stints in my mitral valves," Leo says.

He was suffering from <u>mitral valve regurgitation</u> – a condition in which the mitral valve does not close

properly. In a healthy heart, blood moves from the heart to the body and then back to the heart. For patients with mitral regurgitation, the mitral valve, which acts as the door between the body and heart, does not function properly, disrupting the blood cycle.

Three days after surgery, Leo was walking and able to return home to continue his recovery. Two months after his procedure, he was able to start attending Saint Agnes' Cardiac Rehabilitation and Lifestyle Program. He quickly began to feel like himself again.


